
WHEREAS, the Circuit Judges of the 18th Judicial Circuit adopted local Circuit Court Rules on November 16, 2004; and

#### 34.06 DUI Eligibility for Felony Enhancement for Municipal Prosecutions

Municipal prosecutors shall be required to notify the State's Attorney's Office of all charges of Driving Under the Influence that are potentially eligible for felony enhancement prior to the first court date. If a defendant's driving record is not available prior to the first court date, the municipal prosecutor shall obtain the driving record and notify the State's Attorney's Office as soon as possible upon receipt. (See 65 ILCS 5/1-2-1.2 and 625 ILCS 5/11-208.5)
